ROLL CALL – (Roll call is the time when participants are expected to check in by). Check in is then followed by inspection for fitness, lameness, or “in season” females) FOR THESE EVENTS WE WILL BE HOLDING A “ROLLING ROLL CALL” AND EVENTS ARE CONCURRENT.

WHEN YOU ARE READY TO RUN, YOU COME AND WE WILL CHECK YOUR DOG AND YOU WILL THEN WAIT IN THE READY LINE. First Come first served. Will be running both Trial 1 and Trial 2 at the same time.

If entry limit is not reached, DOS entries will be accepted up. Only hard copy entry forms with PayPal, cash or checks will be accepted for DOS entries.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

All dogs run at owner's sole risk.
Dogs must be one year of age or older on the day of the test. (Sept 20, 2018)
Each dog requires an individual entry form for each event in which it is entered.
Dogs must have an AKC, PAL or Canine Partner registration number.

Site Specifics

This is a rain-or-shine outdoor event. Please plan accordingly.
Please bring your own shade, chairs and water.
Our Fast CAT course is fenced with 5' permanent fencing.
*Bitches in season will be refused entry fees if presented at inspection, entry fee refunded less Adm fee \$10. Dogs that are injured while doing Fast CAT will not be eligible for a refund. Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures, or the "agreement" found on an official AKC entry form.
No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, a public emergency, or any other cause beyond the control of the club or its members or representatives.

Gas powered machine with continuous loop lure machines will be used. The lure will consist of plastic strips.
An electric timing system will be used.
Any person, upon reasonable complaint, can be asked to leave the grounds of the field trial by the Field Committee and may be disciplined by the AKC.
Children must be under control of their parent(s) or guardian(s) at all times.
A \$5.00 fine will be assessed on the owner or handler of any dog loose on the field not competing in the course in progress.
You are responsible for controlling your dog(s) and children.
A return check fee of \$35.00 will be assessed for any check returned for insufficient funds.
Refund Policy: There will be no refunds after the pre-entry close date. Bitches coming in season after closing will be required to supply a statement from their vets that bitch is in season. A \$10 Adm fee will be deducted from the refund fees.
All entries that use PayPal will have the PayPal fees deducted from refund fees.
The host club and Brylin Obedience Specialty School and its members will not be held responsible for any accidents at this event.
All AKC Rules regarding sportsmanship and conduct apply.

Directions to Trial Site

Directions: From East or West, take I-40 to 52 North. From Highway 52 take Exit 123 (King/Tobaccoville). At the top of ramp turn toward the city of King. Just past rail road tracks, turn left onto W King Street. After passing Fire Station, BOSS is at 416-D W King Street. (The far end of the building past the Rock Church.)

Awards

The host club will give a light blue ribbon for a passing run. **Awards will be given at 11:30am for Event 1 on Saturday and Sunday. Awards will be given for Event 2 on Saturday and Sunday at 2:30pm .** At each trial, BOSS will sponsor new title ribbons. BOSS will also sponsor a ribbon for: Road Runner rosette for each event. 1-3 flat ribbons will be awarded for each height class.
