Late, incomplete, unsigned, unpaid, conditional entries or entries without registration number will not be accepted. Entries WILL NOT be acknowledged by phone or mail. Please fill out an entry for each hound for EACH day.

ANY RETURNED CHECK WILL BE ASSESSED A RETURNED CHECK CHARGE of \$40.00.

Eligibility: Only Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzoi, Cirneco dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Italian Greyhounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Norrbottenspet, Peruvian Inca Orchids, Pharaoh Hounds, Portuguese Podengo Medio/Grande, Portuguese Podenjo Pequeno, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Sloughis, Scottish Deerhounds, Thai Ridgebacks, and Whippets that are at least one year of age. The hound must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club or an AKC recognized foreign registry or have an ILP or PAL number from the AKC. Norrbottenspet, Peruvian Inca Orchid, Portuguese Podengo Medio/Grande, Sloughi and Thai Ridgbacks recorded with AKC Foundation Stock Service (FSS).

Late, incomplete, unsigned or UNPAID entries will NOT be accepted. Entries will NOT be acknowledged by mail. Bitches in season, hounds with breed disqualifications and lame hounds will be excused and their entry fee refunded. Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched. Owners may substitute for lame or in-season hounds but must do so before day of trial entries close. Please do not bring bitches in season to these trials, just report the bitch in-season to the trial secretary.

Conditions of Entry: Hounds under disqualification for AKC, ASFA or CKC field trials may not be entered in Open, Veteran or Specials Stakes.

AKC Tests:

QC/JC Tests: A hound at least 12 months of age. The course is a minimum of 600 yards with a minimum of four turns.

TRIAL STAKES OFFERED:

SINGLES: Any eligible sighthound including those disqualified to run in other stakes may participate to run.

OPEN: Open only to hounds of eligible breeds (with no breed disqualifications) that have attained one of the following: AKC QC, Field championship title from ASFA or the CKC. Championship points earned from the Open Stake will only count toward a FC title. Hounds that have earned an AKC FC title are not eligible to enter the Open Stake.

SPECIALS: Open only to all hounds that have earned their AKC FC title. Championship points earned from the Specials Stake will count towards LCX titles.

VETERAN: Open to all hounds which are eligible to enter either Open or Special Stakes, and meet the age requirement for a veteran as established by the breeds' parent club. Championship points will be awarded. Points from the Veteran Stake may count toward either a FC title or LCX title.

BEST IN FIELD (BIF): Will be offered both days. Note: Italian Greyhounds and Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are not eligible to compete for Best in Field.

The lure will consist of highly visible plastic strips and will run on a battery-powered continuous loop system. Back-up equipment will be available.

A penalty of \$5.00 will be assessed for any hound that is loose on the field and not in competition with the course in progress.

There will be a \$5.00 fee assessed to anyone who fails to pick-up after their hound.

NO SMOKING or tobacco of any kind allowed on the trial grounds.

NO parking on the grass. Fine will be assessed by AMA (Academy of Model Aeronautics).


Bring your own shade and water. Clean up after your dogs.

Any person, upon reasonable complaint, may be asked to leave the grounds of the field trial by the Field Committee and may be disciplined AKC.

Practice will be offered, equipment and time permitting. Cost will be \$3 per practice run.

COURSE PLANS:

The course plan will be reversed for finals, run-offs, Best of Breed and Best in Field. ILCC reserves the right to alter the course as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the trial.

CAMPING and RV parking Allowed in designated areas only. Call the AMA at (800)-435-9262 Charges may differ, and are regulated by AMA.



All campers must register with AMA. Register during normal business hours (8 a.m.-5 p.m. Monday through Friday; Museum Store 10 a.m.-4 p.m. weekends, closed Sundays Thanksgiving through Easter) at the Administration Building or the Museum Store. Campers who use electricity and stay longer than 6 nights will receive a discount on their rental fees.

A RV dump station is available on site.

Due to Indiana State Board of Health requirements, all campers (primitive & RV) MUST register at one of the above mentioned locations. If someone arrives after hours, he/she should register first thing the next business day.

This will be monitored closely.



DIRECTIONS:

FROM THE EAST: Take Exit 149B which is Rt 35 North. Take Rt 35 north for approx.

Imately 33 miles to Rt 67. Take a right onto 67 and look for the Memorial

Drive exit. Take the Memorial Drive exit and turn left at the end of the road.

The AMA facility is on your right. Follow the ASFA signs to the field.

FROM THE NORTH (CHICAGO AREA): Take I-65 South to Route 28 East to I-69.

Go south on I-69 to Exit 332 East. This will go through Muncie's business and mall area. Exit at Route 67 South and go to Memorial Drive. Exit at Memorial Drive and turn left at the end of the road. The AMA facility will be on your right. Follow the ASFA signs to the field.

FROM THE NORTH (FT WAYNE AREA): Traveling south on I-69 take Exit 332 East

Which goes through Muncie's business and mall area. Exit at Route 67

South and continue to the Memorial Drive. Exit at Memorial Drive and go

left at the end of the road. The AMA facility will be on your right.

Follow the ASFA signs to the field.

FROM INDIANAPOLIS AREA: From I-465 take the exit for I-69 North. Follow I-69

North to Rt 67 East (Exit 234). Go approximately 14 miles and take the

exit for Memorial Drive. Turn left at the end of the road and the AMA facility is on your right. Follow the ASFA signs to the field.

PROCEDURES TO FOLLOW REGARDING COVID-19

MASKS MUST BE WORN BY EVERYONE except when you are at or in your vehicle (except when your dog/(s) are being inspected and you would be required to wear a mask at that time).

You would be required to wear a mask when running your dog(s).

Everyone including the Field Committee, Judges and exhibitors need to maintain 6-foot distancing whenever possible.

ROLL CALL and INSPECTION will be performed on one dog at a time at the exhibitors' vehicle. If you have entered a bitch, you will SWIPE YOUR OWN DOG and show the inspection committee the tissue. The inspection committee will wipe down the wickets after each dog has been inspected.

Hand sanitizer and wipes will be provided on the table located under the tent.

The Huntmaster will be positioned 6 feet from any exhibitor after inspecting blankets and slip leads.

At the starting line, all dogs will stand 6 feet apart.

Please wait until the draw sheets and/or score sheets have been posted to check your dogs' blanket color or score. Obtain that information quickly by using your own paper and pencil or using your phone to avoid congregating.

If you are ill, coughing, sneezing or running a temperature. PLEASE STAY HOME!!!
