

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee of \$25.00 to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash only basis.

ENTRY FEES will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellations of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

NO ENTRY shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

NO DOGS wrongly entered in a class may be transferred to another class, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the AKC Rules Applying To Dog Shows.

Best of Breed

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition:

Dogs that are Champions of record, which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championship is unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owners' records. If, at the end of the 90 days period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by The American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed Competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by the AKC.

VETERAN DOG **VETERAN BITCH**

For dogs or bitches seven (7) or more years of age. Neutered dogs and Spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Veteran Classes at independent specialty shows. (AKC Dog Show Rules, Chapter 14, Section 8).

BEST PUPPY

Best Puppy in Show Competition: The 6-9 and 9-12 puppy class winners shall be judged immediately following Best of Breed to determine Best Puppy. An entry in the puppy class that is awarded Best of Breed or Best of Winners would automatically be Best Puppy in Show.

BONANZA KENNEL CLUB of CARSON CITY - RESERVED RV OVERNIGHT PARKING INFORMATION - 2022

Hours RV Overnight will be available: Thurs - Sept 29 - 4:00 PM - 10:00 PM; Fri - Sept 30 - 6:00AM - 7:00AM & 3:00PM - 10:00PM; Sat Oct 1 - & Sun Oct 2 - 6:00AM - 7:00AM; All vehicles must be off the grounds 1 hour after BIS - Sun - Oct 2, 2022. No overnight parking on Sunday.

OVERNIGHT & DAY OF SHOW PARKING ARE PRIVILEGES OF CARSON CITY PARKS DEPARTMENT, FUJI PARK, & BONANZA KENNEL CLUB of CARSON CITY. THESE PARTIES RESERVE THE RIGHT TO WITH-DRAW PRIVILEGES, WITHOUT RETURN OF RV OVERNIGHT PARKING FEE OR ENTRY FEES, FROM ANY PERSON(s) WHO CANNOT ABIDE BY, ABUSES THESE PRIVILEGES, OR USES ABUSIVE LANGUAGE. VIOLATORS MAY BE SUBJECT TO EVENT COMMITTEE CHARGES.

The Parks Dept or Club takes NO responsibility for vehicles towed in violation of parking laws or regulations & subject to actions of regulatory officers or agents. Vehicles illegally parked will be towed at the owner's expense. The fire department has forbidden any vehicles in fire lanes or any unauthorized area.

PARKING SPACES WILL BE PRE-ASSIGNED. PEOPLE WISHING TO PARK TOGETHER MUST SEND IN THEIR RESERVATIONS TOGETHER, however there is no guarantee that we can accommodate all requests.

COST: \$35.00 PER NIGHT / PER SPACE. Spaces are 22' x 40'. Vehicles over 40' total length or vehicles with a slide out that will not fit in a 22' x 40' space will need to buy 2 spaces. If your entire package will not fit in a 22' x 40' space, you will need to buy additional space. **Trailers & tow units may be required to be unhitched.** Vehicles over 40' in length will be accommodated only where possible. Tagalong vehicle is \$30.00 flat fee, & must fit into assigned space. (A **TAG** is a vehicle that arrives with a RV or a vehicle that will be parked in the same space as the RV – everything must fit.)

VERY LIMITED HANDICAPPED PARKING will be available; IT MAY NOT NECESSARILY BE CLOSE TO THE RINGS. A suitable access will be provided. Please provide proof of your valid handicapped license with your RV Overnight reservation form. NO NON-RESERVED RV HANDICAPPED WILL BE AVAILABLE. Handicapped RV parking does not guarantee an electric hookup.

There is no guarantee that your parking space will have access to electricity. ELECTRICITY <u>CANNOT</u> BE RESERVED, ASSIGNED, REQUESTED, SAVED & / OR GUARANTEED. Please be prepared if you do not have electricity. There will be NO "Piggy Backing" into another rig who is plugged into the Parks Dept electricity. NO CORDS across any sidewalks, walkways, roadways, or fire lanes. Any violators will be disconnected immediately, & MAY be subject to an Events Committee Charges. <u>Please remember electricity</u>, <u>IF available</u>, is extremely <u>limited</u>, you SHOULD NOT expect to have, get, find, or be guaranteed electricity, no matter what time you arrive or where you are parked. Payment of RV overnight parking fees does not guarantee electricity. Should you get electricity, all connections must be made with club adaptors - A/C must be run with generators.

No Vehicle traffic in show limits during judging hours.

No Visitors may drive their cars into the RV overnight area, they must park in the day of show lot and walk inside.

ALL RV's MUST HAVE A WORKING FIRE EXTINGUISHER.

All vehicles must be completely self-contained. NO discharge of gray water &/or sanitary tanks allowed.

All RV's using a generator must have a proper exhaust pipe, venting away from dogs & people. Quiet time: 11:00 PM – 6:00 AM–No generators

All vehicles will be parked in the same direction in rows &/or side-by-side &/or head to tail. STRICTLY ENFORCED

RV OVERNIGHT PARKING COORDINATOR ASSIGNS ALL SPACES. DO NOT PROCEED TO ANY RV PARKING SPACE without an escort.
