REGULAR AND NON-REGULAR CLASS TROPHIES

This is a condensed form of the Premium List as provided in Chapter 6 Section 2A of the AKC Rules Applying to Dogs Shows. A list of breed and obedience prizes and trophies offered can be obtained by writing to the Show Secretary. If a dog completes an AKC title by a win or qualifying score at these shows, he/she is entitled to a special "New Title" rosette from the show secretary.

NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES COMPETITION (NOHS)

The purpose of the AKC NOHS is to recognize and showcase the quality dogs being exhibited by owner/handlers and to provide a venue for the owner/handlers to compete against their peers. The determination of the awards in the AKC NOHS is based solely on the quality of the entry. The owner/hander's handling ability is not of consideration. There is no fee to enter; just check box on the entry form. The handler must be an owner as of the date of the show. Professional handlers, household members and current assistants to professional handlers are not eligible to exhibit in this competition. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/ weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Jr. Show may participate in NOHS. Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner throughout classes through Breed competition. In these two concurrent specialties, there is no Group competition after Best Owner-Handled is selected during BOB.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

ISSCM has Opted Out of the Pilot Junior Showmanship Program at these specialties

<u>Novice Class</u>: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have not won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Junior Showmanship Novice class at a licensed or member show. Classes are not divided.

<u>Open Class</u>: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, on the day of the show, have won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Junior Showmanship Novice class at a licensed or member show. The Open class is not divided.

<u>Master Class</u>: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, on the day of the show, have won the 10 Best Junior wins with competition present to be eligible to enter this class competition.

PLEASE NOTE: Juniors must include their AKC Junior Handler number on the entry blank. Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form. Dogs shown in Junior Showmanship may have Full or Limited AKC registration or have an ILP/PAL number. Altered animals are eligible to be shown, but bitches in season are not eligible. Effective July 1, 2022 (and adopted for a one year trial period), Jr. Handlers may show dogs they or their immediate family do not own.
